## Southside Baptist Network Associational Mission Strategist 2022 Annual Meeting Report

Our churches established this Network on March 1, 2013. Since then, the Lord has blessed us with over 80 congregations in Clayton, Fayette, Henry, Rockdale, Spalding, Coweta, and DeKalb counties.

The mission of SBN is to equip leaders and encourage congregations to engage our communities with the Gospel.

Thank you for the privilege of serving you these 9½ years. If you have not heard, I have announced my retirement effective June 30, 2023. Dr. Randy Wood is doing an excellent job leading the AMS Search Team. Please add that Team to your prayer list.

Here are some of the ways God is using your prayers, participation, and gifts to the Southside Baptist Network:

- During the 2021-22 school year, six **Pastor Cohorts**, a Discipleship Ministers Cohort and a Children's Ministers Cohort met monthly and studied Dr. Steve Viar's book, *Loving Your Community*. Steve is Pastor of Faith Church, Lafayette, IN.
- Feb. 13-18, eight of us travelled to Faith Church, Lafayette, IN, for the **Faith Biblical Counseling Training Conference**, and 12 participated online. Those attending in person also toured the three community centers they operate.
- Our Annual SBN Children's Homes Food Drive/Truck Loading, Feb. 28-Mar. 3 went very well.

- The annual **SBN Ministry Assistants Appreciation Luncheon** April 21 was well attended. Retired Glen Haven, McDonough, Pastor Stan Berrong, and his wife, Jackie, provided the program.
- **GBMB West Central Region Partnership** with Stockbridge Area Churches: Stan Jordan, Virtual Strategy Coordinator, participated in a Missions Conference at Roopville Road Church, near Carrollton, March 4-6. A group helped Tanners Baptist Church with their VBS and other projects. A youth group from Flat Creek Baptist Church in Fayetteville will have an MNOW instead of a DNOW emphasis prayer walking and canvassing in the Stockbridge area in November. GBMB will use this as a promotion for other churches to consider doing the same thing.
- **Equip 2022** was Saturday, Aug. 27, 8:30am-Noon, at Glen Haven, McDonough. Dr. Steve Viars, Pastor of Faith Church, Lafayette, IN, was the Keynote Speaker. The theme was "Loving Your Community." Approximately 250 participated. Several said it was the best one yet.
- **Cohorts**: This school year we have five Pastor Cohorts studying Mac Lake's book, *The Multiplication Effect: Building a Leadership Pipeline That Solves Your Church's Leadership*
